From I-85 (heading north), take exit #91, Clairmont Road (turn right)

OR

From I-85 (heading south), take exit #91, Clairmont Road (turn left)

- Turn right at light onto N. Decatur Road.
- Turn right at light onto Clifton Road.
- Turn left at light onto Houston Mill Road.

- Turn left onto the first street, Rollins Way.
- Immediately turn right into the first entrance (the Student/Staff Parking entrance) to the Michael Street Garage.

Park and take the shuttle, which will pick-up every 5 minutes from the garage entrance and take you to the summit venue, the Woodruff Health Sciences Center Plaza. Parking and the shuttle are free.
